## HISTORY OF HIRBS

HIR is an annual challenge match between Scotland, England, Ireland and Wales. With Jersey having been invited for the first time this year to compete.

The Teams, which comprise of four separate teams (Senior Men, Senior Women, Junior Men and Junior Women) are selected annually by each nation's Team Selectors and comprises of athletes, coaches and support staff.

The HIR provides an opportunity for rowers and coaches to gain their first taste of international competition.

Although the event originally started as a River Rowing event, last year saw the inaugural Beach Sprints event. Hosted in St. Andrews and won by Scotland

## POINTS AND RESULTS

Points from each race will be awarded as follows:


No points are scored by a crew that is disqualified, or that fails to complete the course by reason of its own accident. Crews deadheating will share the points for the places involved i.e. equal $1^{\text {st }}$ means $31 / 2$ points each.

In the event of only one entry to an event, no medal will be awarded.

In the event where only 3 crews are entered, then the points shall be: $1^{\text {st }}=3$ points; $2^{\text {nd }}=2$ points; $3^{\text {rd }}=1$ point.

Although Jersey will not be awarded Team Points the individual athletes will be eligible for individual medals.
